



## **International Consultants (Maritime): Air Pollution & Energy Efficiency**

### **Call for Expression of Interest (Step I)**

The Global MTCC Network (GMN) project, funded by the European Union (EU) and implemented by the International Maritime Organization (IMO), is issuing an open call for interested consultants/experts in undertaking project related consultancy work. This call for EoI is accompanied by a role specification and a request for respondents to provide:

1. an updated CV in English (incl. information on date of birth, country of residence, languages capabilities)
2. an Expression of Interest (incl. motivation)

Expressions of Interest will be assessed by an Evaluation Committee setup by the Project. Shortlisted consultants will be contacted and further advised.

#### *How to participate in Step I*

#### **Role specification**

Priority will be given to candidates with at least 5 years of progressive experience:

- in GHG emissions and/or climate change areas and/or shipping energy efficiency; air pollution from ships
- in prevention of marine pollution and MARPOL application (needs assessment, awareness and implementation)

Minimum requirements:

- Graduate degree in maritime, environmental science or energy/climate change related field
- Knowledge of IMO Regulations in general, and in depth knowledge of MARPOL Annex VI
- Experience in delivering training courses / lectures
- Demonstrated effectiveness in developing and maintaining unbiased and professional working relationships with counterparts
